- 2. Approval of April 18, 2007 minutes. Motion-Garlock, Hall
- 3. Approval of Treasurer's report. Motion-DeMarco, Vent
- 4. Correspondence From:
 - a. Letter from Wally Blucas, PIAA President, looking at possible new sport classes.
 - b. Letter from Rod Frisco, Harrisburg Patriot-News Sports Writer, concerning PIAA Strategic Planning Committee.
 - c. Meyersdale request to drop the coop with Berlin in Cross Country. It cannot be done right now since only in 1st year.
- 5. Southern Fulton request to begin Junior High Boys Soccer in 2007 approved. Motion to approve-Batzel, Beachley
- 6. Discussion Items:
 - a. All tickets and financial forms are ready for spring sports playoffs.
 - b. The committee continued the discussion of considering changing the method of ranking in team wrestling and possibly other sports for district championships. After much discussion, the item died due to the lack of any motion. There will be no changes.
 - c. The newly formed District 5 Athletic Director's Association will award two \$500 scholarships to female senior athletes and two \$500 scholarships to male senior athletes. These will be announced and presented at the District 5 Track Meet. The PIAA District 5 Committee gave \$1500.00 toward this project.
