- 4. Correspondence From:
 - a. Meeting With District 8 Chairman Concerning Football AA Regional Between 5/8.
 - (1.) 11th play date Both District 5/8 must have champion in place. Undecided yet, possible definite by August 6 meeting.
 - (2.) 12th play date District 5 champion will play District 8 champion. Will rotate championship at the site of the home team, 2008 in District 8 and 2009 in District 5.
 - (3.) Each PIAA District will keep their own revenues, including the subregional championship that they host. The host PIAA District will staff, pay, and keep all gate receipts for all playoff games in their district.
