1. The District 5 Committee meeting was convened at 2:30. Mr. Kimmel conducted meeting.
2. Approval of the May 7, -2008 meeting minutes. Motion-Batzel, Knisely
3. Approval of the Treasurer's report. Motion-Beachley, Hall
4. Correspondence From:
 - a. Meeting With District 8 Chairman Concerning Football AA Regional Between 5/8.
 - (1.) 11th play date - Both District 5/8 must have champion in place. Undecided yet, possible definite by August 6 meeting.
 - (2.) 12th play date - District 5 champion will play District 8 champion. Will rotate championship at the site of the home team, 2008 in District 8 and 2009 in District 5.
 - (3.) Each PIAA District will keep their own revenues, including the sub-regional championship that they host. The host PIAA District will staff, pay, and keep all gate receipts for all playoff games in their district.
 - (4.) 13th play date - District 5/8 Champion will play District 9 Champion.
5. Correspondence To:
 - a. A written report on the Fannett Metal baseball incident of May 12, 2008 was sent to the District 5 Chairman by July 1, 2008.
 - b. The Rockwood, Turkeyfoot Volleyball co-op is still on hold.
 - c. PIAA steering committee assignment changes are still being worked on and should be finalized for the August 6 meeting.
6. Discussion Items:
 - a. Beginning in 2008-2009, athletic physicals will be one per year for three sport seasons. This is good for athletes, schools, and athletic directors.
 - b. The new transfer rule was voted down and sent back to the table for re-working.
 - c. Handbook updates for 2008-2010. Will be Online Only. Playoff dates are completed and official's fees, meeting dates, and all other items will be looked at August 6.
 - d. 50/50 ticket sales are up to the district. It is our decision.
 - e. Cheerleading is being referred to a commottee again to see if it should come under PIAA jurisdiction. This is the 3rd time in 10 years.
 - f. AA Basketball playin will be with District 6. District 5-2 will play District 6-3 at a District 6 site.
 - g. School reimbursement is being looked at by the PIAA. The \$500 minimum may be changed to maybe so much a mile and a fee on tickets sold.
7. Final spring sports reports were given by spring sport chairmen.
