#### 8. Discussion Items

- 1. Update on the football officials meeting. It was discussed and agreed that we need:
  - (1.) We need an official evaluation method.
  - (2.) The reps say we need evaluators to do official evaluations.
  - (3.) Better communications are needed between officials, coaches, and schools.
  - (4.) Officials need to view game tapes and use them as teaching tools for the improvement of officials.
  - (5.) The committee will do tapes of playoff games and give them to the official chapters for training purposes.
  - (6.) The official's chapters are to meet and to bring ideas for a later meeting, in May if ameeting is held.
  - (7.) Official crews will be selected by evaluation and merit, not by chapters or specific crews.
- 2. Official scorers at district playoff basketball games were discussed. Schools should not use young students. One young girl was using a cell phone while trying to score the game. Scorers will not be paid in 1st round games. The district will pay for 2nd games and beyond.
- 3. The PIAA is again discussing the adoption of 6 classes in football and a 15 or a 16 week season beginning in 2012-2013.
