### 9. Sports Reports:

- a. Football There will be no seeding meeting. All tickets must be official District 5 tickets. No home school tickets or comps can be used. Paul will send details of the procedures for ticket sales to all Athletic Directors involved with district playoffs in all sports.
- b. Wrestling Due to construction, Windber High School will not be available for the 2016 Individual championships. A survey was sent out to all district schools concerning the possible available sites for the championships.
