In an effort to increase the revenue for the District V Committee the following options were suggested and will be discussed at the next meeting to be held on Tuesday, September 9, 2025:

- Teams Must have a .500 record or better to enter the District V Playoffs.
- Schools will pay their own PIAA School Dues or a % thereof.
- Have an entry fee for teams to enter the District V Playoffs
- Give medals to team champions only.
- Give medals to players and coaches only. Any other medals will need to be purchased by the school
- Increase ticket prices or pass on the \$1 ticket charge to the purchaser.
- Have one price for tickets. ie. No Adult / Student options
- Increase individual championship entry fees.
