

Bedford's Leah Shackley completed her scholastic swimming career with another spectacular season. The senior won 2 state championships and set 2 new PIAA and Kinney Natatorium (Bucknell) records this year in the 100-yard backstroke and the 100-yard butterfly. She swam a 50.29 in the butterfly and a 50.76 at the PIAA championships. She also broke the District 6-2A records. She was named the Swimmer of the Meet for Class 2A for the third year in a row. For her career, she won 8 medals at states including 3 golds in the 100-yard butterfly, 3 golds and a silver in the 100-yard backstroke, and a sixth-place medal in the 100-yard freestyle. Shackley will be competing in the 2024 US Olympic Trials in Indianapolis in June. She has the Bedford County record for most PIAA championships with 6.
