Reminder to schools that do not sponsor Cross Country as a District V Sport. The following is the position of the District V Committee:

- 1. Schools that do not sponsor cross country as a sport may enter individuals for competition in the District V Tournament.
- 2. Each school must have a coach.
- 3. All students must have a physical examination and maintain academic eligibility.
- 4. Eligibility sheets must be made available to other schools participating in the District V Tournament.
- 5. No school which has entered into a cooperative agreement with another school may enter contestants in individual competition.

Directions to Bedford Technical Center:

The course is located behind the Tech Center, which is located just off Route 30 between Bedford and Everett.

From Everett: Follow Route 30 West about 2-3 miles outside of Everett, take the exit labeled Pennknoll Road. Continue on this road as it winds around the Bedford Hospital. At the stop sign, Make a left and cross the overpass. The Bedford County Technical Center is the first building on the left.
