PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. As stated above, there will be a **\$15.00** registration fee for each participant. A check made out to PIAA District V should accompany the registration form.
2. There will be a separate tournament for Boys and Girls. Both tournaments will take place on the date and at the site mentioned above.
3. Schools with a boys team or co-ed team will play five (5) golfers and score four (4) golfers. Schools with a girls team will play up to five (5) girls and score three (3) golfers. All substitutes should be listed on each team roster. There are no substitutions unless injury or illness ***and*** approved by the Tournament Director. Schools who do not meet the minimum number of players for a team are not eligible to be the district team champion.
4. One (1) boy and one (1) girl will advance from the district tournament to the individual state tournament.
5. The District V AA team champions will play the District III AA team champions to advance to states. District III will host this competition at Briarwood Country Club (York) on Monday, October 10 at 1:30 PM. In order for a team to advance to the state tournament, the boys' team must shoot 400 or less and the girls' team must shoot 300 or less.

6. Schools may enter participants in the District Tournament even though the school does not sponsor a team during the regular season. This applies to both boys and girls. See Attachment #1.
7. Schools may field a team composed of both males and females if they do not field ***both*** a male and a female team. For instance, a school's team may comprise four boys and one girl. If a school has three female golfers, that is a female team.
8. Each school ***must*** have a coach accompany their team to the tournament. If you have girls competing, schools should bring a second coach and include their name on the registration form.
9. Please complete and return the form below to the Tournament Director no later than *Thursday, September 29, 2022. Please send your entry fee check with this registration.*
10. The PIAA State Individual Tournament will be held October 17 and 18, 2022 at the Blue and White Courses (PSU) in State College, PA.
11. The PIAA Team Tournament will be held October 19, 2022 at the Blue and White Courses (PSU) in State College, PA

Attachment #1

The following is the position of the District V committee:

Schools that do not sponsor golf as a sport may enter individuals in the District V Tournament pending the following requirements:

- Each school participating in the tournament must have a coach accompany them on the day of the tournament.
- All participating students must have a physical examination and maintain PIAA academic eligibility.
- Eligibility sheets must be made available to other schools participating in the District V Tournament.
- No school that has entered into a cooperative agreement with another school may enter contestants in the individual competition.
