P.I.A.A. DISTRICT V POINTS SYSTEM:

1. A team receives 4 points for a win.
2. Bonus points are awarded on the following basis:
 - a) 1 point awarded for a win over a Class A school, total of 5 points
 - b) 2 points awarded for a win over a Class AA school, total of 6 points.
 - c) 3 points awarded for a win over a Class AAA school, total of 7 points.
 - d) 4 points awarded for a win over a Class AAAA school, total of 8 points
3. A team will be awarded half of the points for a tie. (2.5-A) / (3-AA) / (3.5-AAA) / 4.0-AAAA)
4. No points are awarded for a loss regardless of opponent's classification.
5. Victories over out of state opponents or non-PIAA opponents will receive the lowest point total (5 points).
6. Tournament games, scrimmages, and exhibition games (Example: Alumni Games) **do not** count in the rankings.
7. Forfeiture of a contest will be governed by P.I.A.A. regulations.
8. Rankings are based on all school schedules that are turned into the District V Statistician by the first legal starting date for that sports season. If games are lost by a school because a scheduled opponent disbands their team before the first legal play date, they may schedule other games for ranking. If games are lost by a school because a scheduled opponent disbands their team after the first legal play date, they may receive forfeits for the games lost.

TIE BREAKING SYSTEM FOR RANKING ONLY! **APPLIED IN ORDER:**

1. Head to head victor, if teams played each other.
2. Winning percentage versus all common opponents in all games played (regardless of the number of times two schools play each other)
3. Bonus points as calculated by wins by defeated opponents divided by games played.
4. Winning percentage calculated by wins divided by games played, with ties counted as

½ win and ½ loss.

5. Greatest number of wins, excluding tournaments, scrimmages, and exhibitions... an example is an alumni game.
6. Coin toss at a site convenient to both schools.
7. Tie breaker system for rank of 8th place only – The flip of a coin, at an agreed site, between both schools, will determine where the game is played for the scenario of a play-in game for eighth seed.

DISTRICT TOURNAMENT – RANKING and PLAYOFF **INFORMATION 2011**

1. A minimum of 14 games played are necessary to qualify for playoffs.
2. Ranking is determined by total points accumulated divided by the total games played. (Excluding tournaments, scrimmages, and exhibitions...an example is an alumni game.)
3. Eight schools will advance into the District 5 Class “A” Playoffs. “AA” Schools (Bedford, Somerset) will play in the District 6 tournament. Dates, game times, and sites for the “AA” tournament will be determined by District 6.
4. Additional qualifiers in Class “A” must have won at least 50% of their games, excluding tournaments, scrimmages, and exhibitions; through a play-in system if warranted.

District 5 Tournament Infomation: (Bedford & Somerset in compete in the District 6 Tournament)

1. First round competition will be as follows:

1st & 8th Place
2nd vs 7th Place
3rd vs 6th Place
4th Vs 5th Place

1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Place teams will host these games on their home fields.

2. Second round competition will be the semi-final matches.
These games will be played on a neutral site.

Winner of 1st vs 8th plays the winner of 4th Vs 5th
Winner of 2nd vs 7th plays the winner of 3rd vs 6th

3. Semi-final winners will advance to the championship game to be played at a neutral site.

4. Travel, field availability, and facilities will be criteria for neutral site selections.
5. The tournament director will contact the Principal and/or the Athletic Director of both schools prior to establishing the playoff site. Any feedback from participating schools regarding the final site must be communicated directly to the Tournament Director within 2 hours of initial contact. The Tournament Director will relay any feedback to the District Chairperson, who will make the final decision on neutral site selections.

Friday, September 2, 2011 – Using a District V Rating Sheet, a copy of the 2011 schedule must be received by the Tournament Director.
