SUBJ: DISTRICT 5 GIRLS SOCCER INFORMATION

DATE: June 24, 2016

- I. It is that time of year again for the submission of our girls' soccer schedules for ranking purposes. If we all work together and each of us does our part, rankings should be out to schools in a very timely fashion. Please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions or concerns. - II. District 5 Girls Soccer Rating system
- A. Ranking is determined by total points accumulated divided by the total games played, excluding tournaments, scrimmages, and exhibitions.
  - B. The top 6 rated schools will compete in the Class A District 5 Tournament. Teams that have a .500 record or better the day of the district cutoff will be included in the District 5 Playoffs through a play-in system.
  - C. Class AA schools (Bedford, Chesnut Ridge, Everett) will be in a sub regional with D6.
  - D. Class AAA school (Somerset) will be in a sub regional with D6.
  - E. The PIAA has 4 classifications for ranking purposes. (A, AA, AAA, AAAA)

### III. Important Dates

All play-off dates are subject to change due to inclement weather or any unforeseen circumstances. In such an event the next day will become the make-up date.

### IV. Point System

- A. A team receives 4 points for a win
- B. Bonus points are awarded on the following basis:
  - 1. 1 point awarded for a win over a class A school, total 5 points
  - 2. 2 points awarded for a win over a class AA school, total 6 points
  - 3. 3 points awarded for a win over a class AAA school, total 7 points
- C. No points are awarded for a loss regardless of PIAA classification
- D. Victories over non-PIAA or out of state opponents shall be worth the lowest point total of 5
- E. Rankings are based on all school schedules that are turned into the District 5 Girls' Soccer statistician by the first legal playing date for the season and no games added after the season begins may be counted
- F. Ranking is in order of total points accumulated divided by the number of games played, excluding

tournaments, scrimmages, and exhibition games  
G. Forfeiture of contests will be governed by PIAA rules

V. Tie Breaker System for Ranking Only

- A. Head to Head victor if the teams played each other
- B. Winning percentage versus all common opponents in all games played (regardless of the number of times two schools play each other)
- C. Bonus points as calculated by wins by defeated opponents divided by games played
- D. Winning percentage calculated by wins divided by games played. Ties count as half.
- E. Greatest number of wins, excluding tournaments
- F. Coin toss at site convenient to both schools

VI. Girls Soccer Schedule

- A. Complete the Girls Soccer schedule form with information concerning your school. Note that 11 games is the minimum number to be played to qualify for the playoffs.

- C. Turn in dates by athletic directors no later than 9:00 am to the statistician are as follows:
  1. Monday, September 12
  2. Monday, September 19
  3. Monday, September 26
  4. Monday, October 3
  5. Monday, October 10
  6. Monday, October 17
  7. **Tuesday, October 18 daily until district cutoff – October 25**  
**\*e-mail is the preferred method for the ratings**
- D. Results should be e-mailed on dates listed above. Schools not reporting will appear at the bottom of the rankings.

VII. To be eligible for the playoffs all teams must have their league schedule complete by the district cutoff date. Any scheduling difficulties should be referred to the Tournament Director.

VIII. Top Six Class “A” and any other teams with at least a .500 record will qualify for the District Playoffs. The #1 and #2 highest ranked teams in Class “A” will get a bye the 1<sup>st</sup> round if team #7 & #8 do not have .500 or better records. Home site advantage and will be given to the higher ranked team for the 1<sup>st</sup> round. Thereafter, the highest ranked teams will be the designated home team.

Possible Play-in Games (played on the “Play-in” date listed above):

If a #9 or #10 would also have a .500 record or better, #8 would host #9 and #7 would host #10. If #6 and #7 are tied with records below .500, then a play-in game will be played at a neutral site.

1<sup>st</sup> Round - #1 Team vs. # Bye or #8 if a .500 record or better  
Class A #2 Team vs. # Bye or #7 if a .500 record or better  
#3 Team vs. #6 Team  
#4 Team vs. #5 Team

IX. After the first round all games will be played on a neutral site with the highest ranked team as the home team unless teams #1 and/or #2 do not get a home site advantage in the first round, then they will be hosts for the second round

2<sup>nd</sup> Round – 1<sup>st</sup> seed plays 4/5 winner  
2<sup>nd</sup> seed plays 3/6 winner

- X. Designation of Bench—The Site game manager shall designate the location of each team’s bench prior to pre-game practice.
