I. Girls and Boys Basketball

- A. Ranking is determined by total points accumulated divided by the total games played, excluding tournaments, scrimmages, and exhibitions.
- B. CLASS A Six schools advance in Boys and Girls Class A Districts, others need a .500 record or better by February 19, 2022.
- C. CLASS AA Six schools advance in Boys and Girls Class AA Districts, others need a .500 record or better by February 19, 2022.
- D. Class AAA District V Girls will play in the District V/VIII Regional Tournament. District V will host in 2022. District V Boys will play in the District V/VIII/IX Regional Tournament. (Subject to change)
- E. Class AAAA District V Girls will play in the District V/VI Regional Tournament. District V Boys will play in the District V/VIII Regional Tournament.
- F. PIAA has six classes (A, AA, AAAA, AAAAA, AAAAAA) for ranking purposes.

- VI. Point System
  - A team receives 6 points for a win
  - Bonus points are awarded on the following basis:
    - 1 point awarded for a win over a class A school, total 7 points
    - 2 points awarded for a win over a class AA school, total of 8 points
    - 3 points awarded for a win over a class AAA school, total of 9 points
    - 4 points awarded for a win over a class AAAA school, total of 10 points
    - 5 points awarded for a win over a class AAAAA school, total of 11 points
    - 6 points awarded for a win over a class AAAAAA school, total of 12 points
  - o No points are awarded for a loss regardless of opponent's classification
  - Victories over out of state opponents or non-P.I.A.A. opponents will receive the lowest point total of 7 points. If the District V Basketball Chairmen are provided in writing from the principal of the out of state opponent verification of that school's enrollment figures prior to the due date of the ratings sheets deadline that opponents classification may be changed to fit the PIAA enrollment classification.
  - o Tournament games, scrimmages, and exhibition games do not count in ranking.
  - Forfeiture of a contest will be governed by P.I.A.A. rules.
  - Rankings are based on all school schedules that are turned into the District V
     Statistician by the first legal starting date for that sports season. No games added after the season begins may be counted.
  - Ranking is in order of a total number of points accumulated divided by the number of games played, excluding tournament, scrimmage, and exhibition games.

#### **Championship Rounds**

The games will be played at a TO BE DETERMINED site. The highest ranked team is the home team.

- IX. **Pre-game Practice -** A minimum of fifteen (15) minutes and a maximum of thirty (30) minutes of pre-game practice shall be provided prior to the start of each game. "Shooting practice" at halftime intermission by teams scheduled to play at a later starting time, shall be **PROHIBITED!** Please try to arrive at the game site no earlier than 45 minutes prior to tip-off.
- X. **Designation of Bench and Basket -** The Site Game Manger shall designate the location of each team's bench. Each team's basket for practice before the game and to shoot at for the first half shall be the one farther from its bench. The teams shall change baskets for the second half.
- XI. Cheerleading The PIAA Basketball restrictive cheerleading rule is to be adhered to.
- XII. Coaches The PIAA Basketball restrictive coaches rule will be adhered to.
- XIII. Number of Teams to advance in state playoffs

"4A" Girls - One (1) from Regional (Districts 5/6)

"4A" Boys – One (1) from Regional (Districts 5/6)

"3A" Girls — One (1) from Regional (Districts 5/8)
"3A" Boys — One (1) from Regional (Districts 5/8/9)

XV. **Game Balls** - Presented to officials, if accepted, the following will be the procedure used:

The home team will provide the game ball.

If the balls are not found to be acceptable, a ball will be supplied by the game manager.

XVI. **Play-Off Times** - All game times will adhere to the following schedule, unless a time change is approved by the district chairmen.

**Single game**: 7:00 PM starting time

**Double Header**: 1<sup>st</sup> game - 6:00 PM starting time

2<sup>nd</sup> game - 8:00 PM starting time

**Championships:** 1<sup>st</sup> game - 6:00 PM starting time

2<sup>nd</sup> game - 8:00 PM starting time

- XVII. Nets for the Championship games at the Pitt-Johnstown Sports Center will be cut down by Pitt-Johnstown approved staff. Championship teams will receive the net once they move to the Pitt-Johnstown Hall of Fame Room for pictures. The awarding of medals and trophies will take place on the gym floor. But at no time will spectators be permitted on the gym surface for any reason.
